Pacific Northwest National Laboratory has 2 post doctoral positions available that involve the extension of laboratory methods for characterizing the proteomes and subproteomes of tissues, cells, and biofluids to advance the understanding of systems biology research specifically in the area of non-human primates. Efforts include the developments and application of sophisticated sample preparation methods for extraction of protein/peptides from small samples of biological tissues, cells and fluids. The ideal candidate will have previous experience with comparative quantitative proteomics using the stable isotope labeling and label free mass spectrometric approaches and their application to longitudinal experiments. The successful candidate will be expected to work effectively with an interdisciplinary team of researchers, be self motivated, and have excellent communication skills.
